Downers Grove, IL – The Downers Grove Public Library will be closed temporarily, from Friday, March 13 at 9:00 p.m. with an anticipated reopening of Monday, April 6 in COVID-19 prevention efforts. All programs and meetings have been canceled until further notice.

This decision follows our ongoing conversations with Village community leaders. We will continue to monitor the situation and reassess as more information becomes available.

Closing the library is an extraordinarily difficult decision that we have made only because of these extraordinary circumstances. The health and safety of our patrons and staff is our first priority.
